WARNING

- **The installation of a suitable socket must only be carried out by qualified personnel.**
- Always disconnect all electronic components from the mains before carrying out maintenance work.
- Do not connect the device to the mains if any parts of it have become wet.
- In the event of damage or malfunction, switch off the supply voltage immediately.
- If safe operation is no longer possible, take the device out of service immediately. Safe operation is no longer possible if the device shows visible damage, has stopped working, or if transport damage or damaged plugs/cables are visible.
- Only connect compatible products once they have reached room temperature. If the appliance is too cold, moisture may condense inside it and potentially cause damage.



CARE

Clean the product using a dry cloth only. Disconnect the product from the mains before cleaning.

DISPOSAL:

SOLAR RAPTOR® small electrical appliances must not be disposed of with general waste but must be disposed of properly in accordance with the ElektroG (German Electrical and Electronic Equipment Act). Disposal takes place at local recycling centres and collection points. Old small electrical appliances can be handed in there free of charge.
